



Steps to apply for Financial Aid for Readmit Students

Financial aid is defined as grants and loans. The Stafford loan is available to anyone that makes less than \$250K per year and does not currently have student loans in default status or a felony drug conviction. Men between 18 and 26 years old must be registered for the U.S. Selective Service. Financial aid eligibility stipulates that you must be at least a half-time student and maintain at least a 2.0 Grade Point Average (GPA).

Websites you will need to visit:

- www.pin.ed.gov to retrieve your Pin Number. The four-digit pin is used to sign your FAFSA application. You also have the option of printing a signature page and submitting it with your other finance documents. Using a pin expedites the process.
- Complete your FAFSA by visiting www.fafsa.ed.gov

Things you need to complete your FAFSA:

- Your pin number
- Your 2008 taxes (if married, your spouse's w-2 form)
- Peirce College School Code: 003309

Items you need to print out and fax to the Readmit Department at 215-670-9115:

- Copy of your FAFSA application (can be printed from the site)
- Copy of your Confirmation Page (can be printed from the site)
- Copy of the Signature Page (not needed if using a Pin)
- 2008 tax return (must be signed)
- Master Promissory Note (we will fill in the lender portion, fax first page only)
- Entrance Interview (document provided)
- Independent verification form (document provided)
